Dear Parent / Carer

As you have responded to our online form indicating that you require the use of our childcare service from Monday 23rd March, please find below details of how this service will operate.

School buses are expected to run as normal. However, we would recommend you check with bus operators daily for the most up to date information as this is ever changing.

It is expected that students attend, in full school uniform, from 8.30 am to 2.55 pm each day, entering through the student entrance. The school site will not be accessible outside of these hours.

- Students will be completing the home learning work provided on the school website using laptops and will follow a specific daily schedule.
- There will be no taught lessons and all work will be completed independently.
- All students will be supervised in the heart space throughout the day, seated accordingly, complying with the government's social distancing guidance.
- All PE lessons will be replaced with silent reading and students will need to bring an appropriate reading book each day.
- Students are expected to bring with them a packed lunch and water each day as catering facilities will not be available.
- All other school rules will apply throughout the day including the use of electronic devices.

PLEASE NOTE - If your family is currently in self-isolation and you are a key worker, your child cannot return to school until the 14-day period is up. If your child presents with any of the listed symptoms while at school, then you will be called to collect them immediately and they will need to self-isolate for 14 days in accordance with the government guidelines.
